Title: RESOLUTION: Resolution 2021-21, appointing one member to Board of Health.

Recommended Council MOTION:

That the City Council approve Resolution 2021-21, appointing Dr. Tess Kilwein to the Board of Health for a term expiring December 31, 2025, and authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to sign.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

To benefit from citizen representation on the Board of Health.

Background:

Board of Health is to address issues of concern regarding health and the control of communicable diseases in the Laramie community. Duties of the Board of Health include setting rules and regulations governing their own affairs, to set the duties of the City of Laramie Health Officer, to manage and control all communicable diseases, as well as to prescribe and fix penalties for violation of prescribed rules and regulations.

One (1) vacancy was created on the Board of Health due to expiration of terms for Leslie Comly on December 31, 2020. In accordance with the Laramie Municipal Code, the City Council must make appointments to the Board of Health. Council liaison Sharon Cumbie and Councilor Jayne Pearce interviewed applicants on March 17th and recommended appointment of Dr. Tess Kilwein. Her appointment to the Board of Health has an expiring term of December 31, 2025. One (1) other vacancies still exist on the Board with one requirement of a Doctor of Medicine.
