



Proclamation

IN RECOGNITION OF THE SNOW REMOVAL EFFORTS BY THE CITY OF LARAMIE STREETS, PARKS AND FACILITIES DIVISIONS

WHEREAS, the storm named, Snowpocalypse 2021, dumped approximately 18 to 30 inches of snow accompanied with wind gusts of 40 mph across much of Southeast Wyoming; and,

WHEREAS, the Laramie received over 18 inches of snow with high winds making roads impassable, closing businesses, disrupting emergency services and shutting down most governmental operations; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Laramie, Streets Division, began the process of snow removal on March 14, 2021 conducting work in continuous 24-hour shifts; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Laramie, Streets Division, provided plowing for emergency assistance and conducted efforts well beyond the City's snow removal plan; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Laramie, Parks & Facilities Division, began the process of snow removal on March 15, 2021 in an effort to open City facilities and amenities as quickly as possible; and,

WHEREAS, all Divisions involved with snow removal have, and will continue to remove snow as needed to assist with recovery efforts from this historic event; and,

WHEREAS, the efforts of these crews have not gone unnoticed by the residents, businesses, organizations and others they serve by many signs of appreciation; and,

WHEREAS, the efforts of these crews have not gone unnoticed by their co-workers, supervisors and the Laramie City Council; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the City Council of the City of Laramie do hereby, proclaim our sincere thanks to Streets, Parks and Facilities snow removal crews for their extraordinary efforts during Snowpocalypse 2021 and encourage our residents to applaud these crews for their efforts in making Laramie safe through this event.
