2021 Wyoming Emergency Insect Management Grant (EIMG) Pre-Award Acceptance Letter

On April 15th, 2021 the Wyoming Emergency Insect Management Committee (EIMC) held a regular meeting and awarded the 2021 Emergency Insect Management grants. The City of Laramie has been awarded a 2021 Emergency Insect Management grant for the program titled: City of Laramie West Nile Prevention Plan. However, due to limited funding, the committee did not award the grant for the requested amount. In order for the Department of Agriculture to proceed with the contractual process, the City of Laramie must give pre-approval to the awarded funding levels and agree to any contingencies the committee stipulated below.

The committee urges all grantees to begin researching additional funding options due to the significant reduction in funding to the EIMG grant program.
