



**Agenda Item: Agreement - Intergovernmental**

**Title: Agreement with Wyoming Department of Transportation for Provision of Water**

**Recommended Council MOTION:**

I move to approve the Agreement with Wyoming Department of Transportation to provide water for state highway construction projects in Albany County, to approve the contract therefore and authorize the Mayor to sign.

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**Administrative or Policy Goal:**

To assist in the maintenance and repair of State highways in Albany County, Wyoming.

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**Background:**

For many years, it has been the policy of the City of Laramie to provide water for use on WYDOT road projects. These projects include work on State highways within the city limits, as well as outside city limits and yet within Albany County. Several projects are now scheduled by WYDOT to be completed in 2021 and 2023, that will require the use of water; project numbers and locations are identified in Attachments to the Agreement.

In as much as these projects benefit the traveling public, including residents of Laramie and Albany County, provision of a construction water supply will benefit all parties. The Agreement presented for City Council approval indicates WYDOT will meter each use and make payment to the City at the prevailing rate.
