Bids were received and opened on May 4, 2021 for the delivery of Unit 211/216 10 Yard Dump Truck for the Streets Division. The bids were as follows:

The Floyd's unit is a 2022 Freightliner 114SD with a delivery date of 340 days from receipt of Notice of Award. This unit does not have glow plugs or intake heater, nor are electrical accessories wired through the key switch, heated wipers or windshield, nor does it meet our warranty requirements or our diagnostic software and cable specs. The bed hoist was not the brand we required, and body warranty is 1 year. Five alternates were available for bid. Alternate 1 was a replacement joystick for \$375.00, alternate 2 was dual polymer tanks for \$7,944.00, and alternate 3 was a wing snowplow for \$21,643.00. Alternate 4 was a 24" cab guard included at no extra cost, and alternate 5 was a stainless-steel body for \$8,987.00.

The McCandless unit is a 2022 International HV613 SBA with a delivery date of 400 days from receipt of Notice of Award. Fan clutch is not air operated, nor was bed hoist the brand specified. Manuals were not included. Five alternates were available for bid. Alternate 1 was a replacement joystick for \$375.00, alternate 2 was dual polymer tanks for \$7,944.00, and alternate 3 was a wing snowplow for \$21,643.00. Alternate 4 was a 24" cab guard included at no extra cost, and alternate 5 was a stainless-steel dump body for \$8,987.00.

The Tri-State Truck & Equipment unit is a 2023 Volvo VHD64T300 with a delivery date of 335 days from receipt of Notice of Award. Height exceeds specifications and body has a 1-year warranty. Five alternates were available for bid. Alternate 1 was a replacement joystick for \$425.00, alternate 2 was dual polymer tanks for \$9,129.00, and alternate 3 was a wing snowplow for \$23,728.00. Alternate 4 was a 24" cab guard for \$1,273.00 and alternate 5 was a stainless-steel body for \$5,705.00.

I am recommending the City accept the McCandless Truck Center bid with all alternates for a total of \$142,093.01.

Trade 1 is a 2016 Schwartz M6 Avalanche on a Freightliner M2 chassis with approximately 2,000 hours and an original purchase price of \$233,575.00. Life to date cost for parts and labor are \$8,791.70. This unit is being traded to help right size our fleet and meet staffing levels.

Trade 2 is a 2009 Freightliner M-2 dump truck with approximately 2,000 hours and an original purchase price of \$71,378.00. Life to date cost for parts and labor is \$48,266.00.

Street Division has \$250,607.00 budgeted for the purchase of the unit.
