



Proclamation

IN RECOGNITION OF THE HIGH PLAINS CURMUDGEON SOCIETY

WHEREAS, a group of nine semi-retired gentlemen and curmudgeon supporters, known as the High Plains Curmudgeon Society, approached the City of Laramie for the twelfth consecutive year about community service projects and volunteering their skills, knowledge and labor for the Parks and Recreation Department; and,

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department developed a list of community service projects and needs that the staff would like to complete, but due to time and budget constraints had not been completed; and,

WHEREAS, the High Plains Curmudgeon Society worked a minimum of one day each week from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm from January to the end of May for more than 1,000 hours of volunteer community service completing the projects; and,

WHEREAS, the community service projects completed by the High Plains Curmudgeon Society included building a bench for the Laramie Animal Shelter, shelves at the Laramie Community Recreation Center, repairing the trash enclosure at the Laramie Ice & Event Center, building teeter totters for the Parks & Recreation Department's Mountain Biking program and building a bench and pergola at the Aragon Dog Park.
