



**Agenda Item: Grant**

**Title: Approving the Submission of a FAA Airport Improvement Program (AIP) Grant Agreement for Taxiway Lighting and Runway Guidance System by Laramie Regional Airport**

**Recommended Council MOTION:**

That Council approve the submission of a Grant Agreement for FAA Airport Improvement Program (AIP) by Laramie Regional Airport for \$301,830 for Installing Taxiway Lighting (Taxiway C) and installing Runway 12 Vertical/Visual Guidance System (PAPI) and authorize the Mayor and City Attorney to sign.

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**Administrative or Policy Goal:**

Joint Powers Agreement for the Laramie Regional Airport requires the approval of Albany County Board of Commissioners and City Council to apply for grants.

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**Background:**

Laramie Regional Airport is seeking a grant from the U.S. Department of Transportation Federal Aviation Administration in an amount not to exceed \$301,830 through the FAA Airport Improvement Program (AIP) for airport development by installing Taxiway Lighting (Taxiway C) and installing Runway 12 Vertical/Visual Guidance System (PAPI).

“The Federal Aviation Administration, for and on behalf of the United States, hereby offers and agrees to pay 100% of the allowable costs incurred accomplishing the Project as the United States share of the Project.”
