



Agenda Item: Resolution

Title: Resolution 2021-50, to Appoint Two Members to the Albany County Tourism Joint Powers Board

Recommended Council MOTION:

That Council move to approve Resolution 2021-50, to appoint two board members Kaley Holyfield and Page Malmstrom to the Albany County Tourism Joint Powers Board for a term expiring June 30, 2023, and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to sign.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

To benefit from citizen representation on the Albany County Tourism Board.

Background:

The purpose of the Albany County Tourism Board is to provide for the promotion of tourism in Albany County and to administer the expenditure and distribution of the lodging sales tax revenue; the Board functions to expend and distribute the lodging sales tax revenues according to Wyoming Lodging State Statutes. Term expiration have created 2 vacancies on the Albany County Tourism Board. According to the bylaws no members shall serve more than six (6) year successively. Brad Jackson has met this and is not eligible to apply. Page Malmstrom and Kaley Holyfield currently serve on the Tourism Board. Page was a County appointment and Kaley was from the City. Both applicants are still eligible to serve on this board. Two council members, Pat Gabriel and Bryan Shuster, held interviews on June 15, 2021 with Page. Kaley being an incumbent member didn't need to be reinterviewed.
