Re: Unit 43 Replacement with Fuel Saving Option with Trade In

Bids were received and opened on June 1, 2021 for the delivery of Unit 43 SUV with Fuel Saving Option with Trade In for the Fire Department. The bids were as follows:

Spradley Barr (SUV) Cheyenne, WY	Base Bid \$36,975.00 Trade In 1 \$1750.00 Total Bid \$35,225.00
Spradley Barr (Hybrid Pickup) Cheyenne, WY	Base Bid \$40,368.00 Trade In 1 \$1750.00 Total Bid \$38,618.00
Laramie GM Laramie, WY	Base Bid \$34,000.00 Trade In 1 \$2500.00 Total Bid \$31,500.00

The Spradley Barr unit is a 2021 Ford Explorer Hybrid with a delivery date of 180 days from receipt of Notice of Award. This unit has fabric wheel well liners instead of plastic or rubber. Alternate 1 (all electric) was not available, alternate 2 (Hybrid) was included in the bid, alternate 3 (idle reduction) was included in the bid and alternate 4 (Lithium Ion battery) was included in the bid.

The Spradley Barr Pickup alternate is a 2021 F-150 with a delivery date if 180 days from receipt of Notice of Award. Alternate 1 (all electric) was not available, alternate 2 (Hybrid) was \$3393.00, alternate 3 (idle reduction) was not available and alternate 4 (Lithium Ion battery) was not available.

The Laramie GM unit is a 2022 Chevrolet Blazer with a delivery date of 180 days from receipt of Notice of Award. No alternates were priced, nor was compliance on the spec sheet stated.

I am recommending the City accept the Spradley Barr Hybrid pickup bid with price of \$40,368.00, less trade of \$1,750.00 for a total of \$38,618.00

The trade is a 2010 Dodge Charger with approximately 149,000 miles and an original purchase price of \$19,874.00. Life to date cost for parts and labor are \$4901.16.

Fire Department has \$62,299.00 budgeted for the purchase of the unit. The remaining budget will go towards upfitting the unit for Fire use.
