**Title: MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF ALBANY, WYOMING, AND THE ALBANY COUNTY SHERIFF’S OFFICE AND THE CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING FOR HOUSING MUNICIPAL INMATES**

**Recommended Council MOTION:**

Move to **Approve** Memorandum of Understanding Between the County of Albany, Wyoming, the Albany County Sheriff’s Office and the City of Laramie, Wyoming for Housing of Municipal Inmates, and Authorizing the Mayor and Clerk to Sign.

**Administrative or Policy Goal:**

Intergovernmental Cooperation. Safe and Secure Housing of Municipal Inmates

**Background:**

From 1992 until 2020, City and County had an agreement for housing inmates at the Albany County Detention Center. This Memorandum of Understanding provides for housing of municipal inmates for a five-year period from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2025; there is no continuation clause in the agreement and it will need to be renegotiated at the end of the defined term.

Under the MOU, city will be pay a full day (\$75) and partial day (\$40) fee and any preauthorized medical care for inmates in the custody of the Police Department or sentenced by the Municipal Court. The Sheriff will provide housing at the ACDC and transport and secure prisoners as needed for arraignment before municipal court.
