Good morning,

Thank you for notifying us about this potential action. The street in question is home On the Hook Fish and Chips' national headquarters. Given this, we have specific concerns we would like to voice before the meeting takes place.

1. The street parking along Cherrywood loop is vital to our growing business. We do not have enough parking for all the people we employ in our parking lot. If the parking were removed we would be forced to take very costly measures such as bussing in employees from somewhere such as the fairgrounds (if that would even be allowed). I don't think we are the only business on the loop who would be in this situation.
2. A large part of what we do here is manufacturing and distribution. While we have room on our lot to actively load and unload an 18 wheeler, we do not have room, nor are the lots out here large enough to have room to park them. Sometimes more than one are waiting to be unloaded, other times they get here before business hours and need to wait. It is also not uncommon that they need a safe place to park and rest for compliance with DOT regulation.
3. We have received complaints about larger vehicles being stored on the street, although this is a legal practice, we are in the process of getting permission from the city to build a yard behind our building to store these vehicles in the future. This will not solve our need for street parking in regard to our employees, but it will get some larger stuff off the street.
4. The street in question has a reduced speed limit of 25mph already in place, I can only imagine this was put in place to safely accommodate dense street parking and the frequent maneuvering of large trucks and forklifts considering the default is 30mph.
5. The loop also serves an important public purpose unrelated to our company that I don't want to have overlooked. Many people use the street parking for the purpose of carpooling when they go south. As a business on the loop I can say that this practice is not bothering anyone but it is certainly a convenience for people who live in laramie.
