



**Agenda Item: Memorandum of Understanding**

**Title: Consideration to accept the Memorandum of Understanding between the Laramie Police Department and the University of Wyoming Police Department**

**Recommended Council MOTION:**

I move that Council accept the Memorandum of Understanding, hereafter referred to as "MOU," between the University of Wyoming Police Department and the Laramie Police Department and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to sign.

---

**Administrative or Policy Goal:**

This recommendation aims to update the current Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Laramie Police department and University of Wyoming Police Department. The MOU provides both agencies access to additional resources to appropriately respond to emergencies or exceptional circumstances. Such situations may exceed the immediate staffing, skill, or equipment needs of any individual agency. University of Wyoming Police Department and the City of Laramie may need to seek the assistance of each other's law enforcement agency to provide certified peace officers for law enforcement services. Geographical boundaries of both parties to this agreement are located within the State of Wyoming, enabling each party to assist the other. This Memorandum of Understanding permits the parties to assign certified Wyoming peace officers for law enforcement services within the boundaries of Albany County, Wyoming.
