

CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO: 2023-14

**RESOLUTION APPOINTING TWO MEMBERS TO THE TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION
FOR THE CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING**

WHEREAS, the City of Laramie, Wyoming (herein after referred to as “City”) created the Traffic Safety Commission pursuant to Section 10.08 of the Laramie Municipal Code, to consist of seven (7) members who are appointed by the City Council for a term of three (3) years; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Safety Commission advises the City Council of the legislative improvements and changes requisite for the reduction of street traffic accidents and to relieve traffic congestion; and

WHEREAS, there are currently two vacancies on the Traffic Safety Commission due to terms having expired; and

WHEREAS, diligent advertising has commenced by the City Clerk’s office with two applications having been received during the latest 4-week publishing period and the subsequent interviews having been successfully conducted by City Council Representatives; the following candidates are recommended for approval by the governing body.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE, WYOMING, RESOLVES:

Section 1. That City Council appoint Harold Colby and Nancy Sindelar to the Traffic Safety Commission to fill the current vacancies with terms set to expire January 1, 2026.
