Title:	Presentations related to City of Laramie Albany County Recreation Board Funding Applications received from community entities for FY27.				

Recommended Board Motion:

I move that the Parks, Tree & Recreation Advisory Board receive presentations from applicants applying for Albany County Recreation Board Funding through the City of Laramie process and that information from these presentations be used to create a priority list to present to the Laramie City Council for consideration.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

To provide a prioritized recommendation to the Laramie City Council for grant applications to be submitted to the Albany County Recreation Board for consideration.

Background Information:

Annually in January the Parks, Tree & Recreation Advisory Board considers applications from various organizations applying for funding from the Albany County Recreational Mill Levy administered by the Albany County Recreation Board and the Albany County School Board.

For FY27, all agencies collaborated to create a unified, online form. Applications were due December 19, 2025. The PTR Advisory Board will hear presentations for all 18 applications at their Regular Meeting on January 14, 2026. A special meeting of the Parks, Tree & Recreation Advisory Board will be held on January 21, 2026 at 6:30pm to finalize a prioritized recommendation from the board to the Laramie City Council.

A resolution supporting this recommendation will be submitted to the Laramie City Council in February for consideration. Following the passage of the resolution from the Laramie City Council packets will be delivered to the Albany County School District for review by the Albany County Recreation Board and the Albany County School District no later than March 1, 2026.

This year, 18 applications totaling \$414,650.45 were received. All applicants were notified of the presentation schedule via email on January 5, 2026.
