This request is for the purchase of two sets of soccer goals to be utilized mainly at the LaRamie Soccer Complex during the summer months.

- In 2021 the ACRB approved grant funds for the purchase of goals for 10 soccer fields. At that time, we served 140 kids age 3-6 in our soccer program. Since that time, the program has grown, and in 2025 we had 224 kids in the program, with more on the waitlist. The addition of goals to accommodate 2 more fields would allow us to expand our programming enough to accept registration for all the kids who want to participate. With the World Cup coming in 2026, it is anticipated that soccer will see an increase in interest, and we expect to see larger enrollment numbers as a result.
- The goals and fields are also used by the Laramie Soccer Club as well as the community when our programming is not taking place. We are requesting funding for goals that are 4'x6' in size and appropriate for 4v4 size fields for regulation play. They could also be used for modified play and 3v3 tournaments for youth or adults.
- We would like to purchase 4 goals (to set up 2 fields) with all aluminum, 4" round frame, to match what we already have in inventory. They come with nets and net attachment clips, as well as "J" anchors to anchor the goals into the ground. They can be set up on grass or turf, and are meant to stay out in the weather for a soccer season. They can be disassembled down to individual poles for storage if needed. The quoted price includes shipping.
- These goals will allow us to expand programming without adding to our staffing expenses and will also allow other groups to have use of more space for small-sided soccer as well.

The Downtown Clinic (Clinic) provides healthcare services to people experiencing poverty without health insurance. Preventative medicine has been a foundational principle to the Clinic's healthcare model and access to recreational opportunities and spaces has proven to be effective preventative medicine. In the past two years, two Clinic clients have lost a total of 225 pounds by controlling their diet and using the Rec Center. This weight loss has had a tremendous positive impact on their physical and mental health. The Clinic will use Albany County Recreation Board funding to offset the costs of reduced-rate Laramie Recreation Center multi-day passes for Clinic clients.

- In 2025 CHC created “Coaches Who Care”, high-impact and evidence-based training sessions for coaches of youth ages 10-18. Sessions aimed to equip coaches with knowledge, practical tools, and confidence to identify signs of suicidality, respond appropriately, connect youth to help, and reduce feelings of isolation, loneliness and deaths by suicide among youth in Albany County.
- 2025 sessions trained 49 coaches, mentors, and educators from 19 organizations, and had potential to impact more than 1100 youth. When surveyed, 80% of participants said they felt more confident starting conversations with youth about suicide and mental health – a critical skill in preventing crises and building connection.
- Why did CHC launch Coaches Who Care? 2024 Wyoming Prevention Needs Assessment data shows ongoing challenges in Wyoming mental health, indicating 23.94% of WY teens say they often or always feel lonely; 27.79% of WY teens say they feel hopeless at least some of the time; and 21.79% of WY teens seriously considered or actually attempted suicide in the past year. These numbers demonstrate a need for involving communities in better mental health.

This request seeks funding to replace aging cardio and fitness equipment at the Laramie Community Recreation Center and to add new equipment that better meets current patron demand.
 - The Recreation Center is a major hub for recreation and wellness, serving over 92,000 residents and visitors of all ages annually and experiencing high daily use. A 2021 Strategic Analysis identified the Cardio Theater and Weight Room as two of the top four areas of use, with approximately 80% of patrons regularly utilizing these spaces.
 - To further assess needs, a cardio equipment survey conducted December 5–18, 2025, received over 100 responses. Treadmills and incline trainers were identified as the most frequently used equipment (64%), and respondents noted that many existing treadmills are nearing the end of their service life and would like additional units.
 - Equipment is monitored based on usage hours, mileage, and maintenance needs to guide annual replacement decisions. This year, staff recommend purchasing one treadmill, one incline trainer, one stair mill, and one Smith machine.
 - Pricing provided is from Commercial Fitness, a primary vendor, and is valid for 30 days. When ready to purchase, the City’s procurement policy will be followed by obtaining quotes from two or more suppliers.
