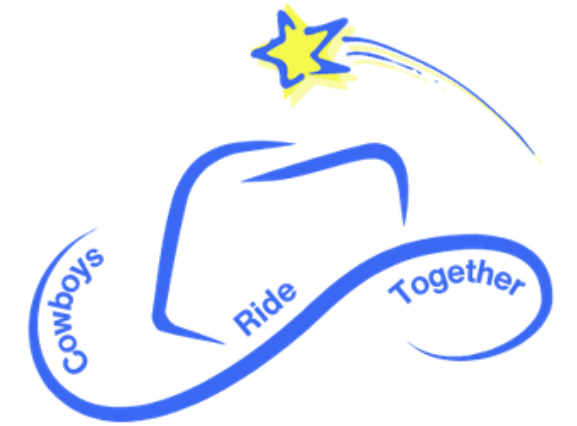

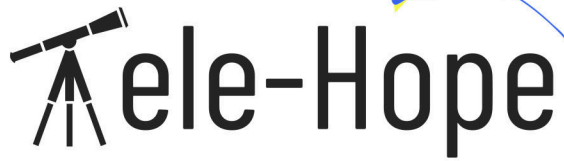

WHAT WE DO

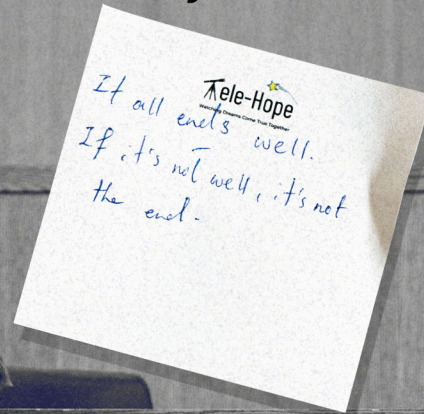
Our workshops are interactive so students can practice these skills in real settings – and more importantly, take them beyond the classroom into everyday life.
