bolstering our community's ability to understand and respond to mental health needs

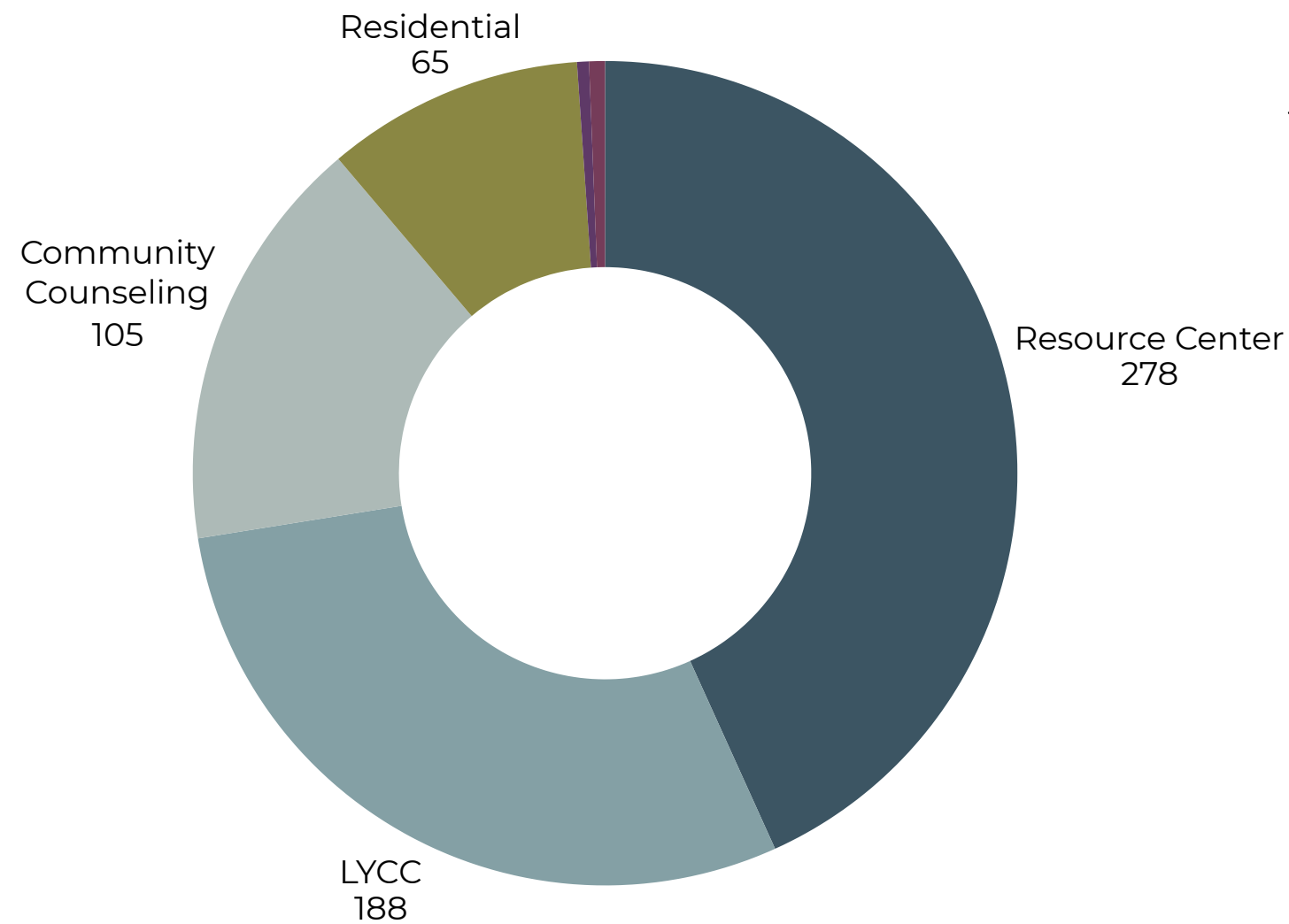

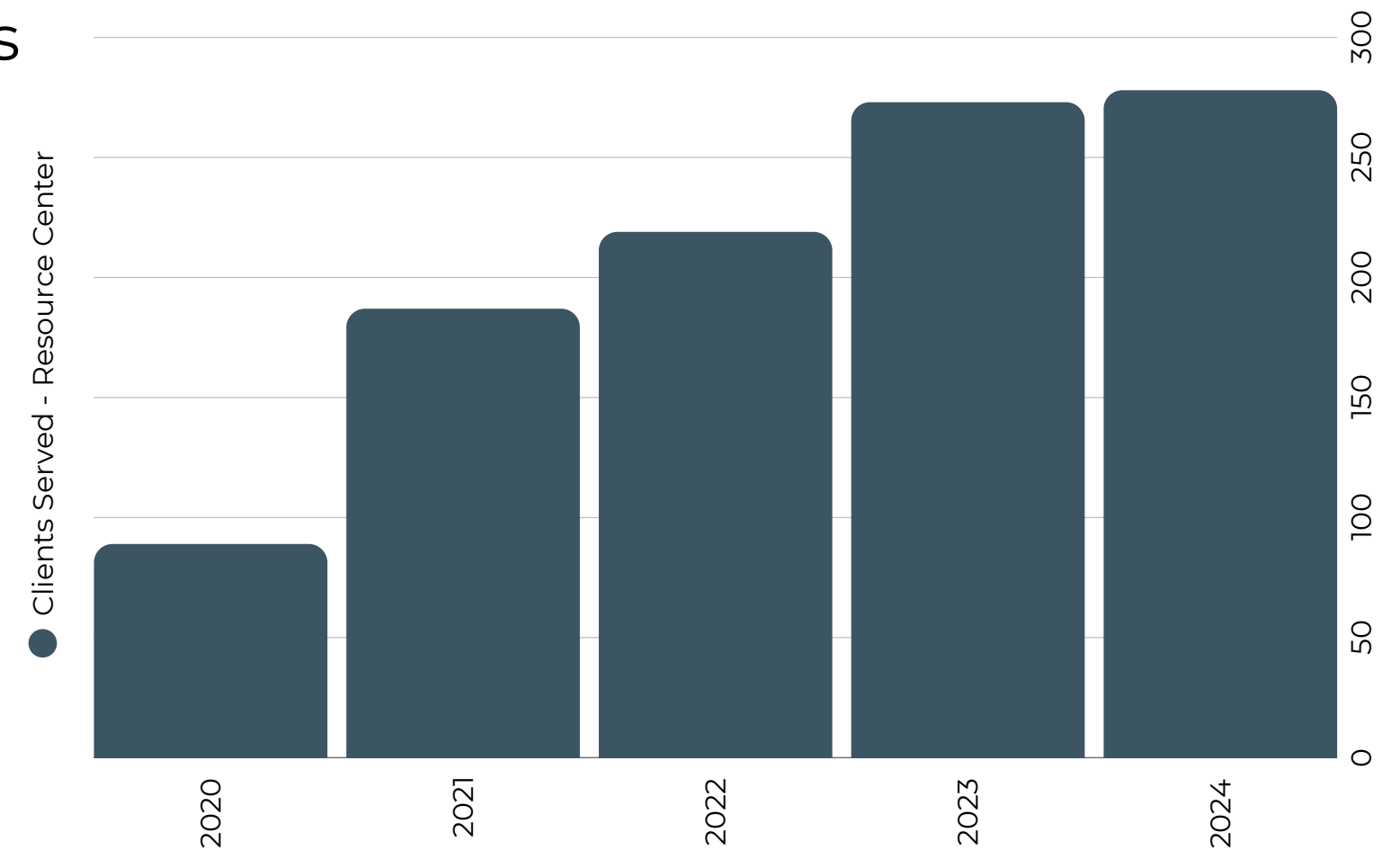

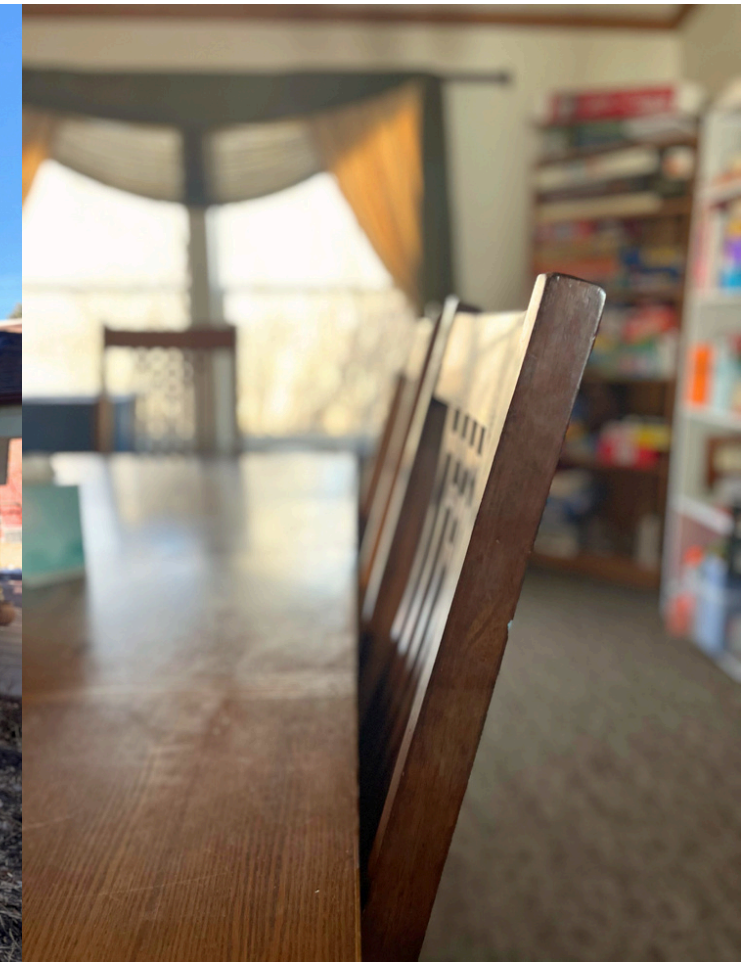

IN 2025,

All Cathedral Home programs combined served 699 individuals.

541 of those individuals benefitted from Community Partner funding



IN 2024, LYCC ...

provided **606 crisis service days**, 645 days of group home care, supported **199 individuals**

saw a **youth crisis rating decrease by 68%** and **family crisis rating decrease by 67%**

received a **4.66 of 5 satisfaction rating** of goals and needs met for youth



IN 2024, THE RESOURCE CENTER ...

supported **342** with family care coordination, case management, or a combination of services

increased social and emotional wellbeing by 16% for those enrolled 6-9 months.
