We provide community support for the sustainability of outdoor spaces in southeast Wyoming.

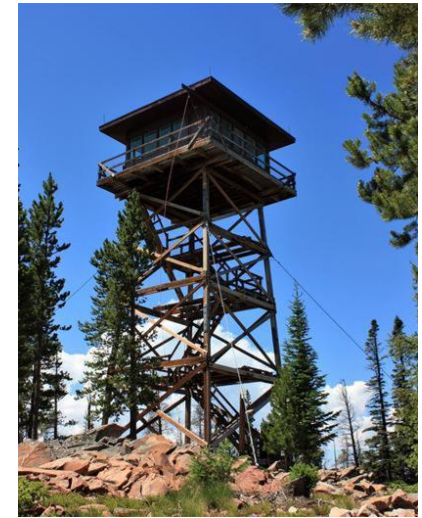
