CITY COUNCIL: RESOLUTION 2026-27**

**A RESOLUTION AMENDING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 BIENNIAL  
BUDGET FOR THE MUNICIPAL OPERATIONS CENTER BACKUP GENERATOR PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Laramie adopted the fiscal year 2025–2026 biennial budget, which included funding for capital improvements and maintenance of municipal infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Operations Center (MOC) houses critical fleet and utility operations necessary to support the City’s ability to respond to routine and emergency service needs; and

**WHEREAS**, the MOC currently lacks backup power, which limits operations during power outages and restricts safe access to essential equipment; and

**WHEREAS**, the City completed an evaluation of backup power needs at the MOC and advanced the project to construction for installation of a backup generator system; and

**WHEREAS**, bids for the MOC Backup Generator Project were solicited and opened on March 3, 2026, and the lowest responsive and responsible bid was received in the amount of \$188,307.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the total project cost exceeds the amount previously budgeted, requiring an amendment to the fiscal year 2026 biennial budget; and

**WHEREAS**, additional funding in the amount of \$78,000.00 is required and will be allocated equally among the Water, Wastewater, and Solid Waste Funds.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE, WYOMING:**

**Section 1.** That the following amendments are to be made to the City’s fiscal year 2026 adopted budget.
