Recommended Council MOTION:

I move that the Laramie City Council approve Resolution 2026-26, establishing a Federal Transit Administration Title VI Program, and authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to sign.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

To create a Federal Transit Administration Title VI Program, ensuring compliance with Federal and State law to receive transit related grand funding.

Background:

The Federal Transit Administration requires all recipients of transit grant funds or operators of public transit systems to have an approved Title VI Program approved and implemented. In collaboration with WYDOT, the City of Laramie has drafted a Title VI Program for future transit activity as the 10-Year Transportation Plan is finalized. This plan will be reviewed and renewed or revised every three years, as required by the FTA. The program outline can be found in Attachment A of the Resolution.
