



Agenda Item: Bid Award

Title: 7 ½ Grand Avenue Sewer Main Replacement

Recommended Council MOTION:

“I move to award the bid for the 7 ½ Grand Avenue Sewer Main Replacement project to Big Huhnks Excavation Inc., Laramie, WY, in the amount of \$72,475.83 along with contingency of \$14,495.17 for a total amount of \$86,971.00, to approve the contract and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to sign.”

Administrative or Policy Goal:

Maintain City-wide Infrastructure Improvement Program as part of the Long Range Financial Plans for water, sewer, and storm drainage improvements.

Background:

Through routine inspections the City of Laramie Utility staff has discovered that the condition of the pipe crossing Grand Avenue, at the intersection of the alley between 7th Street and 8th Street, is in poor condition and requires a complete replacement for repair. The schedule for this project is being driven by accommodating the WYDOT project to resurface Grand Avenue beginning May 28th, 2019. City staff has obtained permits from WYDOT and Wyoming DEQ for the proposed work and has contacted the Albany County Library to discuss the projects impact to their property.

In February 2019, staff solicited bids for the construction of the 7 ½ Grand Avenue Sewer Main Replacement project in accordance with the City of Laramie purchasing policy. Bids were received on March 12th, 2019, with results as follows:

Based on evaluation of the bids staff recommends approval of the Construction Contract with Big Huhnks Excavation, Inc.
