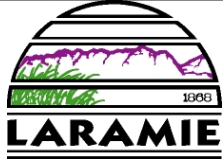

Agenda Item: Presentation

Title: Septic System Impact Analysis, Albany County, Wyoming

Recommended Council MOTION:

None.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

The Casper Aquifer Protection Plan recommended studies to better understand how residential lot and septic system densities impact water quality, and to analyze different residential densities to determine the level of development that the Casper Aquifer can safely sustain.

Background:

Albany County successfully applied for a 205 (j) grant administered by WYDEQ to equip a septic system leach field located in the Casper Aquifer recharge area with monitoring equipment to determine the systems capability in preventing nitrates from entering the groundwater. The study was conducted by Fort Collins, Colorado based Wenck. Albany County was the lead on this project and the City of Laramie was a financial partner. Total project cost was \$60,000, with Albany County and the City of Laramie both contributing \$15,000 and the 205 (j) grant providing the additional \$30,000.
