

**RESOLUTION 2019-46**

**REQUESTING THE DEVELOPMENT OF A PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PLAN  
RELATED TO THE VOLUNTARY REMEDIATION PROGRAM ENROLLMENT  
BY BP PRODUCTS NORTH AMERICA, INC. AT THE FORMER  
AMOCO REFINERY, LARAMIE, WYOMING**

**WHEREAS**, BP Products North America, Inc. is the registered owner of the Former Amoco Refinery located in Laramie, Wyoming; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality has accepted BP Products North America, Inc. for participation in the Voluntary Remediation Program at this site; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Laramie encourages the remediation of this site and its potential return to a productive use of the residents of Laramie; and,

**WHEREAS**, through W.S. § 35-11-1604 any interested party may request the development of a Public Participation Plan by BP Products North America, Inc. for the site; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Laramie City Manager provided notice to the Department of Environmental Quality on May 21, 2019 of the City's desire to develop a Public Participation Plan; and,

**NOW THEREFORE, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:**

**SECTION 1:** To incorporate the foregoing recitals by this reference, and

**SECTION 2:** To affirm it is in the best interests of the community and the residents of Laramie to develop a Public Participation Plan related to the remediation of the Former Amoco Refinery Site as part of the Voluntary Remediation Program, and

**SECTION 3:** To concur with the City Manager's May 21, 2019 request that the Department of Environmental Quality, working with the City of Laramie and BP Products North America Inc., develop a Public Participation Plan for the remediation site which returns the area to a beneficial use.
