AN ACT relating to alcoholic beverages; decreasing the fee for malt beverage and catering permits; and providing for an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Section 1. W.S. 12-4-502(e) is amended to read:

12-4-502. Twenty-four hour malt beverage permit and catering permit; restrictions; application procedure; fees.

(e) The fee for the malt beverage permit and the catering permit shall be not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than ~~one hundred dollars (\$100.00)~~ fifty dollars (\$50.00) per twenty-four (24) hour period, payable to the appropriate licensing authority.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2019.

Catch Title: **Malt beverage and catering permits-fees.**

Subject: Amending the maximum fee for 24-hour malt beverage and catering permits.

Summary/Major Elements:

- Current law authorizes local alcohol licensing authorities to charge an amount from ten dollars (\$10.00) up to one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for a 24-hour malt beverage and catering permit.
- This act reduces the maximum fee amount from one hundred dollars (\$100.00) to fifty dollars (\$50.00) for a 24-hour malt beverage and catering permit.
