**Background:**

In late-February, City Manager directed review, update if/where needed, and implement the municipal Pandemic Outbreak Continuity Plan. Fire Chief Johnson and Human Resources Director Curry supported departmental efforts. The Pandemic Response Team (PRT) has been meeting regularly (daily, at current time) to ensure municipal operations are not interrupted as the services the City provides are necessary throughout any public health emergency to ensure the well-being and health of the community. To-date, all essential municipal services remain functional and at full capacity with the Staff of the City dedicated to serving and supporting the community to the best of our ability through this difficult and unprecedented national pandemic emergency.
