



Agenda Item: Bid Award

Title: Bid Award for Street Rehabilitation Downtown Alley Project

Recommended Council MOTION:

I move to award the bid for the Street Rehabilitation Downtown Alley project to Simon Contractors, Laramie, WY, in the amount of \$98,680.54 along with contingency of \$14,802.08 for a total amount not to exceed \$113,482.62, to approve the contract, and authorize the Mayor and Clerk to sign.

Administrative or Policy Goal:

Maintain and Improve Municipal Infrastructure as Adopted in Resolution 2020-08

To maintain City-wide Infrastructure Improvement Program as adopted in the 2015 Water Master Plan and Long-Range Financial Plans for water, sewer and storm drainage improvements.

Background:

The existing surface of the 2nd/3rd Street Alley between Grand Avenue and Garfield Street is in disrepair which enhances problematic drainage issues. The Downtown Alley project will remediate the surface issues while addressing many of the drainage concerns.

As per the City of Laramie Purchasing Policy, a public bid was held, and bids were provided on February 25, 2020. The following contractors responded to the Bid:

- Simon Contractors
- Elk Ridge Builders & Design, LLC
- Big Huhnks Excavation Inc.
- Hamaker Excavation

After a review of the bid documents it is recommended that the low bid from Simon Contractors be awarded the Street Rehabilitation Downtown Alley project.
