Title: Approval of a Federal Mineral Royalty Capital Construction Account Grant Agreement for the 15th Street Reconstruction Project

Recommended Council MOTION:

I move to approve a Federal Mineral Royalty Capital Construction Account Grant with the Office of State Lands and Investments for \$195,800.00 for the 15th Street Reconstruction Project and authorize the Mayor to sign.

Background:

In May 2020 staff requested authorization to submit a Federal Mineral Royalty Capital Construction Account Grant (MRG) to the State Loan and Investment Board (SLIB) in the amount of \$195,800.00 to supplement SPT construction costs for the 15th Street Reconstruction Project.

In August 2020 staff submitted the completed application to the Office of State Lands and Investments.

In January 2021 SLIB approved the submitted application for the full amount requested.

The project will reconstruct 15th St. between Grand Ave. and Sheridan St. The roadway is deteriorating due to high traffic usage including buses. This section of roadway is proposed to be constructed with 5" of asphalt and 10" of base. The ADA and sidewalks to be reconstructed will be assessed in the design process. Scheduled construction is summer 2021.

Legal/Statutory Authority:

This is a qualifying MRG project and has been approved by SLIB.
