

**CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING  
RESOLUTION 2020-73**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION  
TO THE WYOMING DEPARTMENT OF STATE PARKS AND CULTURAL  
RESOURCES FOR A 2021 LAND & WATER CONSERVATION FUND GRANT  
IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$42,500 TO SUPPORT THE  
REPLACEMENT OF THE KIOWA PARK PLAY STRUCTURE**

**WHEREAS**, the Wyoming Department of State Parks and Cultural Resources has invited cities, towns, counties, schools and recreation districts to submit applications for 2021 Land & Water Conservation Fund grants to support projects that promote, develop, and support public outdoor recreation, and;

**WHEREAS**, for many years the City of Laramie has successfully applied for and received Land & water Conservation Fund grants to provide improvements to our public outdoor recreation program, and;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Laramie submitted specific applications and was awarded Land & Water Conservation Fund grants to support improvements of other park properties in the past, and;

**WHEREAS**, in August of 2018 the residents of Albany County approved the Specific Purpose Optional Sales Tax proposition providing funding for improvements to the City of Laramie park system, and;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Laramie intends to submit a 2021 application to support the removal and replacement of the Kiowa Park play structure and the replacement of the engineered wood fiber with synthetic turf safety surfacing, and;

**WHEREAS**, as required by the Land and Water Conservation Fund, Kiowa Park is owned by the City of Laramie and is dedicated for public use into perpetuity.


**NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE, WYOMING RESOLVES:**

**Section 1.** That all forgoing recitals are incorporated in and made part of this resolution by this reference.

**Section 2.** That the City Council supports the filing of an application to the Wyoming Department of State Parks & Cultural Resources for a 2021 Land & Water Conservation Fund grant in an amount not to exceed \$42,500 to support the replacement of the Kiowa Park Play Structure.
