AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 5.09.050 TO LARAMIE MUNICIPAL CODE RELATED TO MANUFACTURING AND RECTIFYING ALCOHOL

WHEREAS, this ordinance will mirror many sections of Wyoming State Statute 12-2-203 and provide information in Laramie Municipal Code regarding local authority's issuance of satellite manufacturer's permits.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE:

Section 1. That the City Council hereby adding section 5.09. to read as follows:

Chapter 5.09 - ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

5.09.050 - Manufacturing and rectifying.


- A. A holder of a manufacturer's license who is a federally licensed distiller or rectifier may dispense free of charge at the site identified on the manufacturer's license samples in quantities not to exceed one and one-half (1.5) ounces of their product manufactured at the site identified on the manufacturer's license and no more than three (3) ounces of samples per consumer per day. The dispensing of samples shall be subject to the schedule of operating hours set pursuant to Section 5.09.425 and the licensed building provisions of provision in Wyoming State Statute 12-5-201.
- B. The local licensing authority may issue to the holder of a manufacturer's license granted under subsection A of this section who is a federally licensed distiller or rectifier, a satellite manufacturer's permit which allows the permittee to sell product manufactured at the site identified on the manufacturer's license at not more than one (1) satellite location within Wyoming separate from its manufacturing site under the original permit. Products sold at a manufacturer's satellite location may be obtained through the division as provided by W.S. 12-2-303(a). The satellite manufacturer's permit may be issued on application to the appropriate licensing authority. The local licensing authority requires a public hearing and the payment of an additional permit fee set by Resolution in accordance with W.S. 12-2-203.i.
- C. For purposes of this section:
 1. "Distiller" includes any person who:
 - a. Produces distilled spirits from any source or substance; and
 - b. Brews or makes mash, wort, or wash fit for distillation or for the production of distilled spirits, other than making or using of mash, wort or wash in the authorized production of wine or beer, or the production of vinegar by fermentation;
 - c. By any process separates alcoholic spirits from any fermented substance; or

- d. Making or keeping mash, wort or wash, has a still in operation at the site identified on the manufacturer's license.
2. "In operation" means is currently being operated or has been operated in the preceding twelve (12) months with all necessary permits;
3. "Manufacture" or "manufactured" means distilling or rectifying and bottling or packaging any spiritous fluid, substance or compound intended for beverage purposes which contains at least one-half of one percent (.5%) alcohol by volume;
4. "Rectifier" includes any person who colors, flavors or otherwise processes distilled spirits by distillation, blending, percolating or other processes.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective after its passage, approval and publication.
