RESOLUTION 2023-43**

**RESOLUTION APPOINTING TWO MEMBERS TO THE DOWNTOWN  
DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY BOARD FOR THE CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING**

**WHEREAS**, the Downtown Development Authority Board for the City of Laramie, Wyoming (City) is created pursuant to the authority granted under Wyo. Stat. § 15-9-203 et seq. and City Enrolled Ordinance 986; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 15-9-203 and City Enrolled Ordinance 986, City Downtown Development Authority Board shall consist of seven (7) members who are appointed by City Council for a term of four (4) years of which the terms shall be staggered; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 15-9-206 a majority of the members of the board, except any member from the governing body, shall reside, be a lessee or own real property in the downtown development district within the municipality in which the authority is located. An officer or director of a corporation having its place of business in the downtown development district shall be eligible for appointment to the board; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Laramie has three (3) vacancies on the board due to the resignation of member Chaz Avila with an unexpired term of June 30, 2026, and two (2) members, Marty Oblasser and Tom Haas, both with expiring terms of June 30, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section § 15.9.203, City Council shall fill these vacancies.


NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE, WYOMING, RESOLVES:


**Section 1.** That City Council re-appoint Marty Oblasser to serve on the Downtown Development Authority Board for a new term expiring June 30, 2027.

**Section 2.** That City Council re-appoint Tom Haas to serve on the Downtown Development Authority Board for a new term expiring June 30, 2027.
