RESOLUTION 2023-49**

**RESOLUTION APPOINTING FIVE MEMBERS TO THE URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY  
FOR THE CITY OF LARAMIE, WYOMING**

**WHEREAS**, the Urban Renewal Agency for the City of Laramie, Wyoming (City) is created pursuant to the authority granted under Wyo. Stat. § 15-9-106 et seq. and City Enrolled Ordinance 1818; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 15-9-134 and City Enrolled Ordinance 1818, City Urban Renewal Agency shall consist of five (5) members who are appointed by City Council for a term of five (5) years of which the terms shall be staggered; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 15-9-134 the five (5) commissioners of the urban renewal agency shall be selected on the basis living within the area of operation of the agency and their interest in and knowledge of community planning, urban renewal, and business management; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Laramie has five (5) vacancies on the board due to the creation of the agency on December 20, 2022, and pursuant to Section § 15-9-134, City Council shall fill these vacancies.

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF LARAMIE, WYOMING, RESOLVES:

**Section 1.** That City Council appoints Davona Douglass to serve on the Urban Renewal Agency for a term expiring October 31, 2024.

**Section 2.** That City Council appoints John Freeman to serve on the Urban Renewal Agency for a term expiring October 31, 2025.


**Section 3.** That City Council appoints Fred Schmechel to serve on the Urban Renewal Agency for a term expiring October 31, 2026.


**Section 4.** That City Council appoints Lisa Rich to serve on the Urban Renewal Agency for a term expiring October 31, 2027.

**Section 5.** That City Council appoints Abe Lentner to serve on the Urban Renewal Agency for a term expiring October 31, 2028.
